- A. Jesus arrived at the determined time: “hour” for his glorification
- B. His glorification led to and through the pain, suffering and death on the cross
- C. Jesus was able to face the tragedy of the cross, by relying on His Father through deep, abiding prayer


- Just as you have given Him authority over all humanity, so that He may give eternal life to everyone you have given Him. ~ John 17:2
- A. Jesus receives authority
- B. He is granted the power of eternal life
- C. Jesus chooses to grant eternal life to those who believe in Him – Given by the Father
- D. Jesus' authority extends to His own life ~ to lay down His life and take it up again as He chooses (John 10:18)

- Now this is eternal life – that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you sent. ~ John 17:3
- A. Eternal life is defined as “knowing the only, true God and Jesus Christ”.
- B. Know is “γινώσκω” ginosko – A complete, full knowledge.





- I glorified you on earth by completing the work you gave me to do. ~John 17:4
- A. Jesus came to earth with a purpose
- B. He completed his purpose – He didn't quit or give up. This is a model for you and I.
- C. Only the guilty need acquittal
- D. In Christ you are acquitted!



- For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life. ~John 3:16

- A. All that the Father had also belongs to Jesus
- B. Jesus is therefore the ruler of all things – He is God and you must worship Him as God
