- When Jesus had finished saying these things, he looked upward to heaven and said, "Father, the time has come. Glorify your Son, so that your Son may glorify you." ~John 17:1
- A. Jesus arrived at the determined time: "hour" for his glorification
- B. His glorification led to and <u>through the</u> pain, suffering and death on the cross
- C. Jesus was able to face the tragedy of the cross, by <u>relying on His Father</u> through <u>deep</u>, <u>abiding prayer</u>

- Just as you have given Him authority over all humanity, so that He may give eternal life to everyone you have given Him. ~ John 17:2
- A. Jesus receives <u>authority</u>
- B. He is granted the power of <u>eternal life</u>
- C. Jesus <u>chooses to grant eternal life</u> to those who believe in Him Given by the Father
- D. Jesus' authority extends to His own life ~ to lay down His life and take it up again as He chooses (John 10:18)

- Now this is eternal life that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you sent. ~ John 17:3
- A. Eternal life is defined as "knowing the only, true God and Jesus Christ".
- B. Know is "γινώσκω" ginosko A complete, full knowledge.

- I glorified you on earth by completing the work you gave me to do. ~John 17:4
- A. Jesus came to earth with a purpose
- B. He completed his purpose He didn't quit or give up. This is a model for you and I.
- C. Only the guilty need acquittal
- D. In Christ you are acquitted!

- And now, Father, glorify me at your side with the glory I had with you before the world was created. -John 17:5
- A. Jesus was with the Father before He created the world
- B. Jesus was the Creator of all things
- C. Jesus looked forward to his return to his heavenly throne

- "I have revealed your name to the men you gave me out of the world. They belonged to you, and you gave them to me, and they have obeyed your word. ~John 17:6
- A. Jesus revealed God to His disciples
- B. Jesus revealed God to those around Him while on earth
- C. Jesus reveals God to us through the Holy Spirit and the preaching (telling) of His words

- Now they understand that everything you have given me comes from you. ~John 17:7
- A. The Disciples may not have understood <u>everything</u> about Jesus but they understood that He was God's messenger
- B. Jesus depended on the Father
- C. It is our privilege to depend on Jesus, the Father, and the Spirit!

- Because I have given them the words you have given me. They accepted them and really understand that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. ~John 17:8
- For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.
 -John 3:16

- I am praying on behalf of them. I am not praying on behalf of the world, but on behalf of those you have given me, because they belong to you. -John 17:9
- A. Jesus had a special relationship with his Disciples (The 12)
- B. The world can be prayed for only in the hope that people will abandon the world and turn to God.
- C. We ought to pray daily for the salvation of someone!

- Everything I have belongs to you, and everything you have belongs to me, and I have been glorified by them. ~John 17:10
- A. All that the Father had also belongs to Jesus
- B. Jesus is therefore the ruler of all things He is God and you must worship Him as God
