


- It's the climax and the point of Christ's life everything else in NT and Gospels depends on this

- Grace Mercy Love Sacrifice Provision






When Jesus had spoken these words, He went forth with His disciples over the ravine of the Kidron, where there was a garden, in which He entered with His disciples.

- God goes to these great lengths to give us His glory and to complete us and to cause us to worship Him






- ◆ Are you building in times of reflection and quiet

## John 18:2~4 New American Standard

<sup>2</sup> Now Judas also, who was betraying Him, knew the place, for Jesus had often met there with His disciples. <sup>3</sup> Judas then, having received the *Roman* cohort and officers from the chief priests and the Pharisees, came there with lanterns and torches and weapons. <sup>4</sup> So Jesus, knowing all the things that were coming upon Him, went forth and said to them, "Whom do you seek?"








<sup>5</sup> They answered Him, "Jesus the Nazarene." He said to them, "I am *He*." And Judas also, who was betraying Him, was standing with them. <sup>6</sup> So when He said to them, "I am *He*," they drew back and fell to the ground.

### John 18:7~11 New American Standard






### John 18:7~11 New American Standard

# John 3:17~20 New International Version






### John 3:17~20 New American Standard





