#### John 15:12

12 "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.



- why does Christ command us to love one another?
- ♦ b/c we have a natural way of choosing friends/who we love
- Christian love is not just feelings or selfishness
- we must choose to love one another

#### John 15:14~15

14 You are My friends if you do what I command you. 15 No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.



- our love for others is based on God's love and friendship with us
- back to the vine and branches....
- my mind is opened to loving others, though VERY different from me
- don't be troubled; every difficult relationship is faced with the deep
- knowledge that my Father loves me and is empowering me to love others



#### John 15:16

16 You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

- ♦ all done in the shadow of the cross; a call to self sacrifice
- am I bitter or receptive of that?

- your fruit will last; what fruit?

- fruit; are you?

- do my prayers need to change to orient toward God's missions? to be
- fruitful?
