

#### John 7:1-2 (English Standard Version)

'After this Jesus went about in Galilee. He would not go about in Judea, because the Jews were seeking to kill him. 'Now the Jews' Feast of Booths was at hand.

- Christ is in Galilee and has fed the 5,000 20,000 +
- Spent only a few days with the masses
- Spent over 7 months with only His discipleswhy?
- Christ came to redeem people and to make disciples
- God wants His Son's life reproduced in as many people as possible

- As "little Christs" we're supposed to pour our lives into others
- Are you attracted to the 'big show'?
- Are you pouring Christ into someone else?

- The Feast of Booths / Tabernacles
- Fall harvest
- Temporary shelters built to protect crops
- Celebrated Christ's protection in the wilderness
- Symbolized with light and water
- Theologically tied to past preservation and future Messiah

#### John 7:3-9 (English Standard Version)

<sup>3</sup>So his brothers said to him, "Leave here and go to Judea, that your disciples also may see the works you are doing. 4For no one works in secret if he seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show yourself to the world." 5 For not even his brothers believed in him. <sup>6</sup>Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always here. <sup>7</sup>The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify about it that its works are evil. <sup>8</sup>You go up to the feast. I am not going up to this feast, for my time has not yet fully come." 9After saying this, he remained in Galilee.

- Christ was confronted by His brothers who had a belief that was really unbelief
- Earthly wisdom vs heavenly distraction
- Similar temptations will come for us compromise convictions for \_\_\_\_\_\_

- God has timing and a plan
- God is still working on a divine timetable
- God is outside of time, but the Creator of time works in time and is always on time!

- Do you sense God's timing?
- Wait! Pray ⇒ Work ⇒ Watch
- ◆ Act! Move ⇒Go ⇒Do

- The brothers believe something....v. 5 says it's unbelief; Christ confronts this
- I won't go to Jerusalem for your reasons
- When I go, I'm going to die and call you to die
- What you want is fatally flawed!
- The world hates Me but not you why?
- You comfort and validate them (self-worship is OK)
- I expose them (self-worship is evil)

#### John 7:10-18 (English Standard Version)

<sup>10</sup>But after his brothers had gone up to the feast, then he also went up, not publicly but in private. 11 The Jews were looking for him at the feast, and saying, "Where is he?" 12 And there was much muttering about him among the people. While some said, "He is a good man," others said, "No, he is leading the people astray." <sup>13</sup>Yet for fear of the Jews no one spoke openly of him.

#### John 7:10-18 (English Standard Version)

<sup>14</sup>About the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple and began teaching. 15The Jews therefore marveled, saying, "How is it that this man has learning, when he has never studied?" <sup>16</sup>So Jesus answered them, "My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me. 17 If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. <sup>18</sup>The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory; but the one who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood.

- Christ presents several reasons to believe
- Knowledge and authority from God
- Selfless humility
- This directly conflicts with what I want from Jesus....
- Miracles, goodness, religion
- What we want must be changed!
- Jesus says I can't know Him until my will is changed

#### John 7:19-24 (English Standard Version)

<sup>19</sup>Has not Moses given you the law? Yet none of you keeps the law. Why do you seek to kill me?" 20The crowd answered, "You have a demon! Who is seeking to kill you?" <sup>21</sup>Jesus answered them, "I did one work, and you all marvel at it. 22 Moses gave you circumcision (not that it is from Moses, but from the fathers), and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath. <sup>23</sup>If on the Sabbath a man receives circumcision, so that the law of Moses may not be broken, are you angry with me because on the Sabbath I made a man's whole body well? <sup>24</sup>Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment."

- Moses gave you the law; you love and claim Moses; you can't keep the law - you want to kill Me!
- I've come to fulfill the law
- The purpose of the law was for people to worship God
- You've made it a tool for self-worship
- Brothers want to use Christ for self-praise
- Jews hate Jesus because He removes self-praise

- Verse 24 is the invitation for today and all time!
- Don't reject/judge Jesus ignorantly/wrongly
- Come to Christ to have your will born again

- Ask God for a will that is changed to obey
   Christ so you can know Him
- Confess your pride, self-worship and joy from the praise of men
- Ask God for a joy in God's praise
- God, eradicate self-glory from my heart
- Am I in your timing?
- ◆ Wait ⇒ Go


