

John 8:12 (English Standard Version)

¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

- 7 "I am" statements in John
- Light and its importance at Feast of Tabernacles
- 4 huge bowls burned with fire all night
- Candelabras in the courtyard burned all night
- Symbolized:
- Light in the wilderness
- God's presence in the Temple
- The "great light"

- In OT, God is characterized with light
 Pure and holy
- God's revelation
- God's salvation

- For us today:
- Jesus is THE light because He's God
- We need light
- The world needs light
- Jesus is our light in so many ways!

- How does this life and light come to us?
- Follow Him!
- Not hanging out with Jesus
- Imagery of bread and water
- I am so consumed with Jesus that I take Him into myself
- A soldier obeying orders; obeying laws; slave with master; submitting to teacher
 Christ never called us to anything less than an intensely devoted following

John 8:13-18 (English Standard Version) ¹³So the Pharisees said to him, "You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true." ¹⁴Jesus answered, "Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going.¹⁵ You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. ¹⁶Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me.¹⁷ In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true. ¹⁸I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me."

- Christ is saying My authority comes from Myself because of where I come from
- He appeals to the Father 7 times
- I speak God's words as God
- Important because it places miracles and forgiveness in proper perspective; gives them their value

John 8:18-19 (English Standard Version)

¹⁸I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me." ¹⁹They said to him therefore, "Where is your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither me nor my Father. If you knew me, you would know my Father also."

There's a huge difference between knowing all of these things and KNOWING Christ
Is this same gulf between you and Christ? John 8:20 (English Standard Version) ²⁰These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, because his hour had not yet come.

- Who's in the treasury?
- The sincerely fake or the sincerely worshipful
 Either way, they knew their Scripture
 It's here at this time with this group that Jesus says, "I am the light of the world."

John 8:21-25 (English Standard Version) ²¹So he said to them again, "I am going away, and you will seek me, and you will die in your sin. Where I am going, you cannot come." ²²So the Jews said, "Will he kill himself, since he says, 'Where I am going, you cannot come'?" ²³He said to them, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. ²⁴I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I am he you will die in your sins." ²⁵So they said to him, "Who are you?" Jesus said to them, "Just what I have been telling you from the beginning.

- We're connected to heaven or hell based on where our identity comes from
- 1) Identity from the world
- 2) Identity from the Father
- Part of our radical change is a new origin/identity

- 3 times He says you will die in your sins; how can He say that? Why will they die like that?
- "He" is in italics because it's not in the Greek
- Unless you believe I am THE I AM and follow Me with your soul, you will die in your sins
- Beyond knowledge; it's belief!

John 8:26-30 (English Standard Version)

²⁶I have much to say about you and much to judge, but he who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from him." ²⁷They did not understand that he had been speaking to them about the Father. ²⁸So Jesus said to them, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. ²⁹And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him." ³⁰As he was saying these things, many believed in him.

- Verse 29 Not so my Father will accept Me; so that I will be pleasing to Him
- Emphasis is on making Him happy; is this my motivation?
- Stay away from making Him happy with me

- Verse 30 For John, people don't go to hell because they sin
- They go to hell because they reject Christ; it's the sin of unbelief

- Do you walk in light?
- Are you following Christ or hanging out with Him?
- Have you accepted Him or rejected Him? Do it now!
- Do you know Him? Do others know Him because of you?
