



- All major religions ask these questions:
- Who is God?
- Is He knowable?
- What is the solution to man's problem?

#### John 7:40-42 (English Standard Version)

<sup>40</sup>When they heard these words, some of the people said, "This really is the Prophet."

<sup>41</sup>Others said, "This is the Christ." But some said, "Is the Christ to come from Galilee? <sup>42</sup>Has not the Scripture said that the Christ comes from the offspring of David, and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David was?"

- Christ is back in hostile Jerusalem to answer some questions and to raise others - Why?
- To push us to believe...or not
- To raise up believers who will believe no matter what
- Verse 40 has a few believers = the remnant
- God, make us your faithful, believing remnant

- They knew Messiah would come from Bethlehem...Why didn't they know Jesus was from Bethlehem?
- Too busy with silly questions to ask

#### Romans 1:18-19, 22-23 (English Standard Version)

<sup>18</sup>For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. 19For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. <sup>22</sup> Claiming to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup>and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.

#### John 7:43-44 (English Standard Version)

<sup>43</sup>So there was a division among the people over him. <sup>44</sup> Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.

- Why are there such strong divisions about Jesus?
- We present Him in relatively safe and comforting terms
- He made MUCH larger claims about Himself; fantastic claims that beg the question - Will you believe?
- Don't come to Christ or present Him as anything short of this!

#### John 7:45-48 (English Standard Version)

<sup>45</sup> The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, who said to them, "Why did you not bring him?" <sup>46</sup>The officers answered, "No one ever spoke like this man!" <sup>47</sup>The Pharisees answered them, "Have you also been deceived? <sup>48</sup> Have any of the authorities or the Pharisees believed in him?

- In the religious leaders' blaming, you sense their pride and unwillingness to change
- They embarrass the guards and make it sound like you have to choose between Christ and position/power/authority
- These things are not theirs to give!
- Watch out for this kind of mockery
- Lots of pressure for "smart" people to not believe for academic and intellectual respect

#### John 7:49-52 (English Standard Version)

<sup>49</sup>But this crowd that does not know the law is accursed." <sup>50</sup> Nicodemus, who had gone to him before, and who was one of them, said to them, <sup>51</sup>"Does our law judge a man without first giving him a hearing and learning what he does?" <sup>52</sup>They replied, "Are you from Galilee too? Search and see that no prophet arises from Galilee."

- Now we're into 2 kinds of rejection intellectual and volitional = mind and will
- Will addressed in 7:17
- Mind is often a part of God's saving process
- Apologetics an intentional effort to soften the intellectual rejection
- So many great resources


- Who knows someone who's rejecting God with intellectual reasons?
