

## Mark 10:46-52

46 And they came to Jericho. And as he was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a great crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the roadside. 47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" 48 And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" 49 And Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." And they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take heart. Get up; he is calling you." 50 And throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus said to him, "What do you want me to do for you?" And the blind man said to him, "Rabbi, let me recover my sight." 52 And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way.

## Being in on the "Fix" God Has Means We Need To:

V. 47-Recognize it's those who are aware of their maladies that are the most receptive candidates to receive the "fix" from God. Don't evaluate who you think God is going to touch. It may not be who you think.

V. 47-48-Press relentlessly to get what you need desperately

V. 48-How many times to we try to hinder the work that God is doing in someone and for us. (v. 48). Are we a part of the "many"?(see word in v.48)

## Being in on the "Fix" God Has Means We Need To:

V. 48-49- Remember you are a part of people's hearing from God's voice. It is the key to changing a life. How often are we the agent of God's voice or the muffle to it? In verse 49 he says to the disciples: "call him". Jesus could have done this himself but chose to use their voice.

V. 50-Throw down what is secondary to get what is primary

V. 50-52-Sometimes we must get in a position to receive the provision

V. 50-52-Always seek the path of His Presence
