- What has God prepared for me?
- **Ephesians 2:10** (English Standard Version) ¹⁰For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

- ...All prepared by God for you to do good works



- Why aren't we all living a wildly satisfying life that we know matters?
- Because we haven't taken Christ seriously
- Because we are broken
- Will we prepare ourselves or just be angry at God because life seems pointless?
- Christ tells us to prepare ourselves so we can live fully in God's preparations for us



- Luke 14:25 (English Standard Version) ²⁵Now great crowds accompanied him, and he turned and said to them,
- Jesus isn't interested in building a crowd
- He came to change hearts and challenge us to live a meaningful life
- Will you follow Him if He tells you to make preparations that cause more problems?



- Luke 14:26 (English Standard Version) ²⁶ "If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple."
- Prepare your heart
- Isn't Jesus exaggerating?
- No other relationship can be more important than our allegiance to Him
- Are you prepared to follow Christ even if that means problems in other, dear relationships?



- Luke 14:27 (English Standard Version) ²⁷ "Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple."
- Prepare your actions
- Picking up your cross is something you do
- We must die daily to ourselves and love Christ by serving others
- How and when are you prepared to die to yourself and give to others no matter the cost?
- Baptism
- On going lifestyle of service






