
It's easy to see where kids find security...

Moses in chapters 2-4; What do we know about Moses early on?

- •1. The adopted son of Pharoah's daughter
- Egypt
  - 3. Killed an Egyptian
    - •4. Moses=
    - "Son" in Egyptian
  - "Drawn from water" in Hebrew
- Would serve for years to come that God had rescued him and provided,

even from birth







•We cling to it, or we deny it and try to hide it

-All of this was Moses!

 Accept your past as part of you and don't give it disproportionate importance





•Moses has now left Egypt, left his position and culture; he's been in Midian for about 40 years...changed his life!





Though he's come to terms with his new life, maybe he looks back at what used to be and wants that



Some of us get our security from the hope of a "reboot" or a desire for the way things were ~ but we're stuck in the "in-between"



- 1. God delays some things in order to make US right
- 2. God delays some things in order to make the WORLD right



•Embrace delays as times of replenishment and preparation for the task ahead



■¹Then Moses answered, "But behold, they will not believe me or listen to my voice, for they will say, 'The Lord did not appear to you." 2The Lord said to him, "What is that in your hand?" He said, "A staff." 3And He said, "Throw it on the ground." So he threw it on the ground, and it became a serpent, and Moses ran from it. 4But the Lord said to Moses, "Put out your hand and catch it by the tail"-so he put out his hand and caught it, and it became a staff in his hand-5"That they may believe that the Lord, the God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared to you." ~ Exodus 4:1-5 ESV

•We can hold to any or all of these things and hope that they provide security












•What's in Moses' hand?


