

- What is worship? Why do we do it? How do we do it?
- Corporate worship doesn't work if we're not worshiping privately.
- All of Scripture calls us to a sincere corporate worship of God that flows from genuine private worship

2 Samuel 24: 18

So Gad came to David that day and said to him, "Go up, erect an alter to the LORD on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite."



- Gad tells David to buy the land and build and alter; why?
  - x Because David had sinned.
  - × He's trusted in man and in his own strength.
- God has judged and 70,000 are dead.
- The angle of death has stopped at a threshing floor.

- What's a threshing floor?
  - > A place where wheat & grain was separated at harvest.
  - > Symbolized judgment throughout the Bible.
  - > Also a place where blessings were received.



- In the greater context of worship, we begin to understand the threshing floor as:
  - We worship in response to God's great salvation
  - Are you prepared to worship and to meet with God?
  - Are you prepared to submit to his work of separation and transformation?
  - Will you receive the amount and kind of blessing God has for you?

- David purchased the land for an altar = sacrifice and worship go hand in hand
- This was a place of literal sacrifice
- Psalm 51:15-17

O Lord, open my lips, That my mouth may declare Your praise. For You do not delight in sacrifice, otherwise I would give it; You are not pleased with burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

• Romans 12:1

Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship.

• What have you come to sacrifice today?

• 2 Samuel 24:24 However, the king said to Araunah, "No, but I will surely buy it from you for a price, for I will not offer burnt offerings to the LORD my God which cost me nothing." So David bought the threshing floor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver.

Worship costs us something

• Why does David purchase this field?



• 1 Samuel 24:25

David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. Thus the LORD was moved by prayer for the land, and the plague was held back from Israel.

• Because there was a death sentence and deliverance has been provided.

 We worship from gratitude as God, through Christ, has delivered.



- David is worshiping and responding to God's greatness and deliverance.
  - On Abraham's Moriah
  - On Solomon's Temple Mount
  - > On Araunah's threshing floor



- Words in the Bible to help us better understand worship:
- OT-
  - \*Yadah- to extend the hand
  - Tehillah- spontaneous song
  - Barak- to kneel
  - Towdah- thanksgiving offering
  - Zamar- instrumental praise
  - Shabach-loud song
  - Shachach- to fall down
  - \*Abad- to serve

- NT-
  - ▼Proskuneo- to kiss; to fawn over
  - **x** Latreuo- hired servant
  - **x** Eusebeo- reverential fear
  - Sebazo- respect



- In the biggest possible picture understanding of worship, what motivates us to worship?
- 1. We praise what we think is good and what gives us joy.
- 2. Let us praise God, the source and end of our joy.

Jeremiah 9:23-24 Thus says the LORD, "Let not a wise man boast of his wisdom, and let not the mighty man boast of his might, let not a rich man boast of his riches; Behold, the days are coming," declares the LORD, "That I will punish all who are circumcised and yet uncircumcised—

- Worship him by responding to his salvation!
- Are you prepared to sacrifice to him?
- Are you worshiping expressively and biblically?
- Is your joy found only in him, daily?
- Atsab- worship through offerings.
